Minutes

The District Wide Educational Improvement Council (DWEIC) met on Monday, April 26, 2010. The meeting convened at 5:05 PM in the board room of the central administration building. Dr. Blair welcomed the group and reviewed the agenda.

Dr. Joan Slater, Director of ELA, Social Studies, and Advanced Academics, was invited to speak to the group on the state plan for Gifted Education. The state plan, entitled the Texas Performance Standards Projects, encourages gifted students to produce innovative products and exhibit performance of professional quality. The plan consists of five parts: Student Assessment, Service Design, Curriculum and Instruction, Family and Community Involvement and Professional Development for teachers. Dr. Slater mentioned that a parent survey will be posted online and the resulting information will be used to make program improvements. Also, the GT Showcase will be held at Northpointe Intermediate on May 13 at 6:30 PM.

Superintendent Neubauer conducted the open forum portion of the meeting, answering questions on various topics. Dr. Blair reviewed the draft of the District Plan, stating she would make suggested changes and corrections before presenting the final version to the Board in May.

The members were asked to complete a questionnaire on the topics and procedures of the DWEIC meetings and were given a certificate of appreciation for their attendance for the 2009-2010 school year.
